- 1. All upper division FA courses must be taken at UC Denver unless approved by Area Head and/or Department Chair.
- 2. Students must complete a minimum of 120 total credits.
- 3. Students must maintain at least a 2.0 cumulative GPA.
- 4. A total of 45 upper division (3000/4000 level) credits are required.
- 5. 30 total credits must be completed in residency at UC Denver.
- 6. 27 credits of all FA credits (at any level) must be taken at UC Denver.
- 7. 25 credits of total FA courses must be upper division (3000/4000 level).
- 8. Students must check official catalog course description and abide by all published pre- and co-reqs, including minimum grades.
- 9. CAM policy states that students who miss the first two class sessions of any CAM course could be administratively dropped. Likewise, students will not be permitted to add any CAM course if they have missed the first two class sessions.
- 10. Student must apply to graduate online at www.cudenver.edu/registrar. Consult the on-line academic calendar for deadlines.
- 11. Consult the the CAM website, the UC Denver catalog, the UC Denver website and the Visual Arts Student Handbook for complete requirements and policies.
