PARENT/GUARDIAN CONSENT FORM**

The CU Succeed Silver program is a unique program of the University of Colorado at Denver that works with schools throughout Colorado to provide high school juniors and seniors with the opportunity to take courses in their high schools for both high school and college credit. The courses offered in the program are not high school courses for which students earn college credit. They are CU-Denver courses that are taught by CU-Denver full or part-time faculty. Therefore, they are equivalent in content and academic standards to courses taught on the CU-Denver campus.

Students who enroll in CU Succeed Silver courses earn credits just as students enrolled at a University of Colorado campus. The credits earned in the courses can be applied to a degree program at one of the CU campuses (with limited exceptions), or they may be transferred to another college or university (Visit [www.cudenver.edu/cusucceed](http://www.cudenver.edu/cusucceed) for more information regarding the use and transfer of credits.). **CU-Denver cannot guarantee that its courses will transfer to all institutions, nor will it refund tuition for courses that do not transfer. Grade reports are not automatically sent to students. Students may request official transcripts from the transcript office at no cost. Instructions appear on the CU Succeed website.** Transcripts are generally not available until three weeks after the completion of a course.

Enrollment in CU Succeed Silver courses for CU-Denver credit is **optional**. Students who wish to enroll in CU Succeed Silver courses and receive CU-Denver credit must **1) obtain the consent of their parents or guardians on the form below and submit it to their course instructors, 2) register for the courses on the CU Succeed website during the specified registration period, and 3) pay tuition for the courses to CU-Denver at the rate that has been agreed upon by CU-Denver and the student's high school.** CU-Denver will issue a bill to the students, usually 10-14 days after they register. **Students who register for a CU-Succeed Silver course and later drop it will be financially responsible for the course, if they do not drop before October 9, 2009.**
